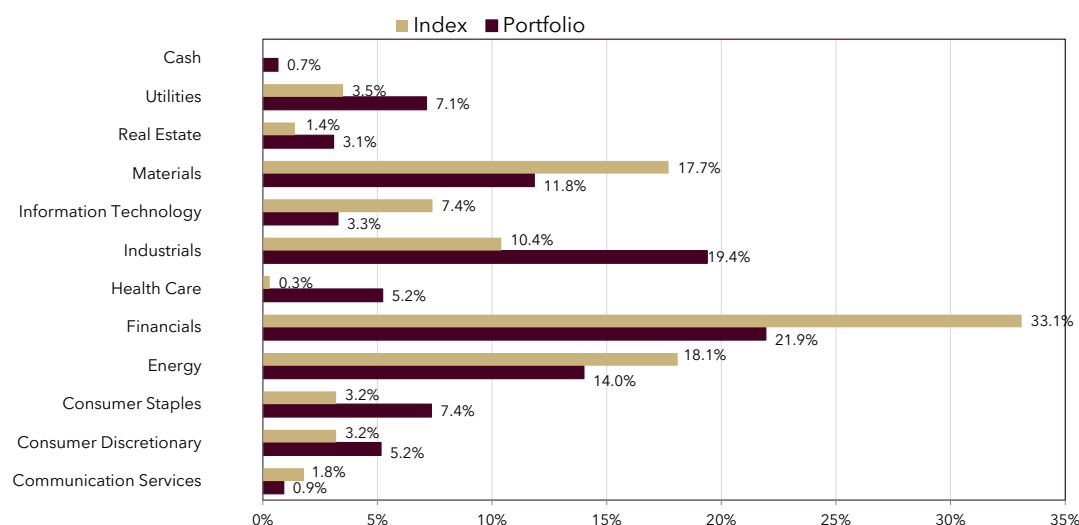
TOP PERFORMERS

Our top performers in the fund in June were **Royal Bank of Canada (NYSE: RY; S&P/TSX: RY)** and **Sun Life Financial Inc. (NYSE: SLF; S&P/TSX: SLF)**, as Canadian financials rallied following the Office of the Superintendent of Financial Institutions (OSFI) announcement that it would lower the Domestic Stability Buffer (DSB) to 3.0% from 3.5% of total risk-weighted assets. Lowering the DSB provides Canadian banks with greater flexibility to deploy capital and support the Canadian economy's adaptation to evolving trade and geopolitical dynamics. The Bank of Canada kept the policy rate at 2.25% in June, which is supportive of stabilizing net interest margins. The insurance and asset management sectors also benefit from higher investment incomes on fixed-income portfolios in a higher-for-longer rate environment.
